



Dear Guest,

We are pleased to welcome you and your pets as our guests to the Doddington Hall Estate. The Doddington Hall Estate is perfect for dog walking with a number of walks varying in both length and terrain. You can pick up a walks leaflet from our Farm Shop.

Well-behaved dogs are welcome in our Country Clothing and Doddington at Home store for a spot of retail therapy. Dogs are also welcome in the outside areas of our Cafe and Restaurant and Coffee Shop, where water bowls are available for a refreshing drink.

We have outlined a few simple guidelines that will help ensure the safety of your pet and other guests whilst visiting our accommodation:

- The cottage (**Holly Farm only**) is prepared to accommodate your pet, provided that your pet is fully house trained. We politely request that you bring their favourite doggy bedding with you and do not let them on any of the furniture in any of the rooms.
- All pets are charged at £30 per dog per stay, which is non-refundable, payable at the time of booking.
- Your pets should also be appropriately restrained by you and it is your responsibility to ensure that your pet complies with local legislation requirements defined in DEFRA Animal Welfare Policy (Control of Dogs)
- You are responsible for cleaning up after your pet on the Doddington Estate.
- Dogs are not to be left alone at any time within the accommodation or the grounds. Any disturbances such as barking must be curtailed to ensure other guests are not inconvenienced.
- We welcome responsible pet owners. However, the Hall does not accept liability for any loss, damage or illness to your pet. You are responsible for any property damage resulting from your pet and the Hall reserves the right to charge an amount commensurate to the cost of such damage following an inspection upon departure. Please be aware that these policies are to protect both parties.
