Scarecrow criteria:

- A photograph of the finished scarecrow must be emailed to hannah@doddingtonhall.com, before drop off. This ensures we can identify each entry whilst onsite.
- We encourage all groups to think of using sustainable and recycled materials
- Must be no taller than 1.8m.
- Must be attached to a pole supplied by the class or group.
- Scarecrows must be substantial, robust, no loose items and all of the individual components must be firmly attached to the scarecrow and able to withstand all weather conditions. (Please bear in mind they will be on display outdoors for the whole half term period).
- A photo of the students with the scarecrow is welcomed to be included in the entry with full permission to be used on our social media pages. To be supplied via email.

Prize:

- The winning scarecrow will be announced on Sunday 30 October via our social media channels.
- Creativity, sustainability and robustness will all be factors considered for the winning entry.
- All entries will be judged by James and Claire Birch and there will be one winner.
- The winning class or group will receive a free Christmas Tree★

Additional:

- All entries must be completed and dropped off at our Farm Shop for set up before 12noon Thursday 20 October.
- All scarecrows will be on free to view and on full display in front of the Gatehouse throughout the October half term (Friday 21— Sunday 30 Oct).

★ Trees are limited to 8ft, will be picked by our Woodsman, netted and must be collected from our Stable Yard.
